

What You Need to Know About Painted Cabinets

It is important to understand that the beauty of wood cabinetry comes from the natural qualities of wood itself. The beauty of these genuine woods lies in the variation of grain. The textures of those natural grain patterns often remain visible with paint finishes and should be accepted as natural characteristics when selecting painted cabinetry. Paint finishes are uniquely different from standard wood finishes. **On all wood products, expansions and contraction are typical due to changes in climate conditions.** Due to the normal movement, paint finishes may develop separation lines, finish breaks, and seam lines. These will be most notable in the white finish. These are normal and are not considered quality defects.

Seam lines and finish breaks (like the picture below) are normal characteristics of paint finishes and should not be considered a reason for product replacement. Also, there may be a slight color shift over time due to exposure to natural and artificial light. We mention these characteristics because we cannot be responsible for these conditions and variations. Please note that this is normal for all other major brands and is mentioned on their websites as well. Below are some examples.
